#### TERMS OF USE:

- No charge for Friends coming to the Library personally to borrow scripts for up to nine weeks for reading purposes.
- Maximum loan: 9 single titles, 1 set of scripts plus 6 singles, 2 sets plus 3 single titles or 3 sets of scripts.
- Ordering by post:- £2for the first script; 50p per each successive script for a period of nine weeks; if kept longer, then this charge may be applied for every nine week period. (One exception will be when the Library is closed for holidays.) An additional charge shall be made to cover postage costs. Cheques to Scottish Community Drama Association'.
- Scripts to be returned as soon as possible either by hand or by post. Parcels, properly packed and clearly labelled may be handed in at Summerhall Reception. The hirer's name should be clearly indicated whether posted or delivered by hand.
- Late returns will be charged at 20p per script per week and will be enforced. Exceptions to return dates will be made when the Library is closed for holidays. Lost items will be charged at current replacement value.
- If the maximum quantity of scripts has been borrowed, no further copies may be taken out until some or all of the current loan is returned. one back = one more may be borrowed.
